For this week's service, Steve Bjella and Lawrence Leviton will present Maurice Ravel's masterpiece: "*Sonata for Violin and Cello*". A revolutionary work written in 1922, this four movement work was a major turning point in Ravel's compositional style and inspired generations of composers.

Lawrence Leviton is Artist/Teacher of Cello at UW-Stevens Point and a scholar in music in film. Steve is Artist/Teacher of Violin and Professor of Music at UWSP and concertmaster of the Central Wisconsin Symphony Orchestra.
