

Plant Your “Victory” Garden

Frost Guidelines:

- Last frost approximately May 15th
- First frost approximately Sept 15th

Note: Read carefully and **trust** the information on your seed packets!

Planting Timetable:

April 1 (6 weeks before last frost)

Start seeds indoors in trays:

Leaf lettuce	cabbage
Head lettuce	broccoli
Parsley	

May 1 (2 weeks before last frost)

Start Seeds indoors in trays:

Tomatoes	Peppers	Sweet Basil	Cucumbers
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Plant Seeds Directly Outdoors

Bush Peas	Carrots	Onions	Radishes	beets
Cabbage	Leaf Lettuce	Broccoli	Head Lettuce	

May 15th (Last frost day)

Plant Seedlings from trays outdoors

Leaf lettuce	Head lettuce	cabbage	broccoli
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Plant Seeds Directly Outdoors

Cucumbers	Cantaloupe	Midget Watermelons
Dwarf Marigolds		

Plant Outside

Potatoes – 4 per Hill, Hills 10” Apart

(Red potatoes require shorter growing period. Harvest 8 weeks replant or use space for other crops.) Harvest other varieties after first fall frost.

Note: if late spring frost occurs, plants must be covered!

May 29th (2 weeks after last frost)
Setout Seedlings (plants) from trays:

Tomatoes Peppers Parsley

Plant Outside:

Corn (Seed 15" apart in a square Block) Bush Beans

June 7th (3 weeks after last frost)

Setout Seedlings (plants) from trays:

Cucumbers Cantaloupe Midget Water Melon Dwarf Marigolds

Plant Outside:

Pumpkins Sunflowers Zucchini Acorn Squash

July 15th (8 weeks after last frost)

Harvest Red Potatoes (only red) Harvest others approximately 2 weeks after vines dry, about Sept 7th

Aug 1st (10 weeks after last frost)

Plant Outside

Second crop of beans

Aug 15th (12 weeks after last frost)

Starts Seeds Inside in trays

Leaf Lettuce Head Lettuce

Sept 1st (16 weeks after last frost)

Setout Seedlings (plants)

Leaf Lettuce Head Lettuce

Plant Seeds Outside (second crop)

Carrots Radishes
